Where we Serve:

Papua

Mountains march across the center of the island of Papua. The ruggedness of these mountains have created some of the most inaccessible valleys in the world. Yet, in these hidden canyons are tribes of thousands who still are waiting to hear the Gospel. To the south and north, between the mountains and the coastline, lie miles and



miles of dense jungle. MAF has been working in these areas for over 50 years, helping missionaries travel in and out of the interior of the island, speeding their work toward completion. MAF has played a key roll in planting hundreds of national churches across the island. In many places, the missionaries would not be able to continue their work without the help of MAF.

Lamet is an Indonesian missionary to his own people. When he was just a small boy a missionary family came by airplane to his village to live. With

this family came his first access to the Gospel, which changed his life forever. As he grew older, Lamet became involved in the little village church, and soon became a leader. For the last ten years he has been taking the Gospel to other villages near his home that have not had a chance to hear the Good News. Lamet's work has been aided and expanded through the continuing service of Mission Aviation Fellowship. The airplane takes him and other men like him to training seminars where he is taught the Bible and basic first aid. As a result, when he returns to the villages where he is preaching, he can bring aid to basic illnesses and a fresh knowledge of God's Word.



Mission Aviation Fellowship has been working in Papua for over 50 years. During that time, dozens of mission and relief



organizations have been served through the use of the airplane. These organizations are now equipping the local church leadership to evangelize their own people. In recent years, MAF has seen a great increase in the national church workers who are making use of aviation as they take over the job of reaching out to their own people.

In order to meet the continuing and expanding need for the airplane throughout Indonesia, MAF is looking for more pilots to go out to serve. In Papua alone, MAF is desperately in need of pilots right now just to meet current demand. And in the next year, that need is projected to increase even more. Pray with me that God will send pilots to help meet the needs of the missionaries and national church as they take the Gospel deeper into the jungles.



I am excited because I have spent the last 14 years preparing to serve as a missionary pilot. God has brought me to MAF at this time, and I'm thrilled to be a part of this ministry.

I am seeking partners who will join with me as I help transport and equip the saints in Indonesia. MAF has asked that I raise \$5,100 of monthly ministry support and an initial outgoing expense of \$21,000. Would you prayerfully consider becoming a financial

How do I start supporting your ministry, and when should I start?

How to financially support my ministry:
